TAMÁS MELLÁR graduated in economics in 1977 from the Faculty of Economics of the University of Pécs (PTE), where he also obtained his doctorate in 1981. From 1991 he was a candidate, and since 2007 is a doctor of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (MTA). He began his career as a research student at the PTE Faculty of Economics. In 1988–1989, he was a visiting researcher at Princeton University in the United States, after which he worked as an academic director at the Privatization Research Institute and chief government advisor at the Prime Minister's Office. Between 1998 and 2003, he was president of the Central Statistical Office (KSH), going on to become deputy director, and then director, of the PTE Illyés Gyula College Faculty. Since 2009 he has returned to work at the PTE Faculty of Economics as a lecturer. PÉTER MEDVEGYEV is a professor in the Department of Mathematics at Corvinus University of Budapest. His research covers mathematical finance and the theory of stochastic processes, and he is the author of numerous books and papers in this thematic area. medvegyev@uni-corvinus.hu

ANDRÁS SIMONOVITS has been working at the Institute of Economics of CERS-HAS since 1970, first as an assistant researcher, then as Research Professor, retiring in November 2016. He spent several months separately at various universities and institutions. Between 2000 and 2015/16, he taught mathematical economics at the Central European University (CEU) and Budapest University of Technology as a Professor of Economics. In 2007, he received the distinction of the Officer's Cross of the Republic of Hungary.
